# Background



#### **Background**

CD4 protein, primarily expressed on the surface of helper T cells, is a crucial component of the immune system. It plays a pivotal role in orchestrating the adaptive immune response by interacting with major histocompatibility complex class II molecules on antigen-presenting cells. This interaction facilitates T cell activation, leading to the production of cytokines and coordination of immune responses against pathogens. CD4 also serves as the primary receptor for human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), enabling viral entry into host cells. Understanding CD4's functions is essential for elucidating immune system regulation and developing therapies for immune-related disorders.

## Instruction

#### Reconstitution

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized protein in sterile  $H_2O$  to a concentration not less than 0.2 mg/mL and incubate the stock solution for at least 20 min to ensure sufficient redissolved.

#### **Shipping**

The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon receipt, store it immediately at -20°C or lower for long term storage.




## **Stability & Storage**


This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C for 12 months in lyophilized state from date of receipt.
- -20°C or -80°C for 1 month under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
