Background



Background

Interleukin 25 (IL-25) is a cytokine with proinflammatory and anti-inflammatory effects, it predicts a molecular mass of 16.7 kDa. It can induce NF-kB activation, and stimulate the production of IL-8, which is the major chemotactic substance of neutrophils.

Reconstitution

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized protein in sterile H_2O to a concentration not less than 200 $\mu g/mL$ and incubate the stock solution for at least 20 min to ensure sufficient redissolved.

Stability & Storage

This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C for 12 months in lyophilized state from date of receipt.
- -20°C or -80°C for 1 month under sterile conditions after reconstitution.


Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Shipping

The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon receipt, store it immediately at -20°C or lower for long term storage.
